

The **Intensive Care** module has 11 beds normally reserved for patients who have undergone heart and vascular surgery, and, when necessary, patients from general surgery; the facility is also used by the wards and haemodynamic and radiology services for the admission of patients requiring respiratory, cardiocirculatory and metabolic interventions, as well as for any urgent or emergency need.

The technological equipment, the high professional standards of the personnel and the immediate access to diagnostic and laboratory services make it possible to carry out complex scheduled and urgent/emergency interventions 24 hours a day.

The module is staffed by a team of specialist anaesthetists and interventionists who, in the context of interdisciplinary activities involving professional nurses, cardiologists, surgeons (cardiac/vascular/general), specialist doctors (nephrologists, pneumologists, etc.) and the family, can guarantee full support to the patient in terms of both diagnosis and treatment.
